OPEN COMPETITION - JUDGE MALIKA BOOKER



Malika Booker is a British poet of Guyanese and Grenadian Parentage. She co-founded Malika's Poetry Kitchen and is a lecturer at Manchester Metropolitan University. With Sharon Olds and Warsan Shire, Malika is published in the Penguin Modern Poets Series 3, Your Family: Your Body (2017). A Cave Canem Fellow and inaugural Poet in Residence at The Royal Shakespeare Company, she was awarded the

Cholmondeley Award (2019) for her outstanding contribution to poetry and elected a Royal Society of Literature Fellow in 2022. Malika is the first woman to win the Forward Prize Best Single Poem – Written category twice, first in 2020 with her poem *The Little Miracles*, commissioned by and published in *Magma 75* (2019), and in 2023 with *Libation*, published in *The Poetry Review* (2022).

GRAHAM BURCHELL AWARD FOR DEVON POETS JUDGE – GRAEME RYAN



Graeme Ryan was brought up in St Anne's on Sea, Lancashire. He taught English and Drama in the Southwest for many years and wrote seven full-length plays for young people, including *Heartland*, *Hope Street* and *Tracks of the Free*. Graeme won the Teignmouth Festival Open Poetry prize in 2018 and collaborated in *The Poetry of Unknown Things* for the 2023 festival. He is a co-chair of Somerset-based Fire River Poets and has read widely across

the Southwest, most recently at Coleridge Cottage in Nether Stowey. His debut poetry collection *Valley of the Kings* was published in 2022.

TEIGNMOUTH POETRY FESTIVAL - 2024 COMPETITION - Rules

- Poems may be on any subject, must be the original work of the entrant, unpublished
 and not accepted for publication in any medium. They must not have been awarded
 a prize in any other competition.
- Poems should be in English and not exceed 40 lines of text, no minimum. Titles, epigraphs, dedications and blank lines are not included in the line count.
- Poems must be typed on a **single** side of A4, and must have a title.
- Each poem must be on a separate page, which must not bear the author's name or any other mark by which the author could be identified.
- **Postal Entries Two** copies of each poem are required, accompanied by a completed entry form (see opposite). One entry form may cover multiple poems.
- Online entries please submit Word document or pdf via the online entry form.
- There is no restriction on the number of poems that may be submitted, provided the appropriate entry fee is included.
- Poems entered will not be returned keep a copy for yourself.
- Each poet can only win one prize.
- Copyright will remain with the author, but the organisers reserve the right to publish any of the prizewinning poems as they deem appropriate.
- Once entered, poems may not be amended.
- The results of the competitions and prize winning poems will be published on <u>www.poetryteignmouth.com</u> . Commended poems will not be published.
- The Open Competition judge will read ALL the entries. The judge for the Graham Burchell Award will read all eligible entries.
- Judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The Festival reserves the right to change the judge/s if the need arises.
- In exceptional circumstances the organisers reserve the right to return poems and entry fees.
- The judges and Festival organisers are not eligible to enter the competitions.
- POEMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY MIDNIGHT 31st JANUARY 2024.
